- 9. Judging will commence following the Jackpot Calf and Heifer shows, Tuesday, July 2, 2024.
- 10. Late entries after July 1, will be required to pay an entry fee of \$125.00 per head.
- 11. All 4-H steers from any club showing at the Weyburn 4-H Inter-Club Show will be eligible to enter in the Jackpot Steer Show for a fee of \$75.00 up until weigh time, 8:00 am on Tuesday, July 2, 2024.
- 12. All entries must be accompanied by an entry fee payable to the Weyburn Agricultural Society. No animal will be allowed to show if the entry fee is not paid in full.
